¹ At the center of God's strategy "to reconcile to himself all things," is a whole, new creation by and in Jesus Christ and him crucified. The heartbeat of this new creation is worship, a provision of God's grace in Christ, by which we learn to feel, think, speak, and act as God's good people.

² "Amen" grows from the Hebrew root meaning "true and faithful;" we pray with hope and confidence because our covenant God is "true and faithful" to his covenant promises.

³ "Benediction" is the "good Word" of God's blessing by which He secures, sustains and equips his people by his steadfast, covenantal love in Christ for the display of His glory

Similarly, as we participate in the hymns and prayers of God's people in Christ from throughout history, we will gain an appreciation for the continuing, present unfolding of God's story of Glory and Grace in Jesus among his people by his Spirit.

Hymn: O Love That Wilt Not Let Me Go (Trinity, #708)

Sermon Notes

Passage: I John 4:7-11 & Galatians 5:16-22

Message: *Fruit of the Spirit: Love*

“Love” is something we hear and talk a lot about in all sorts of ways. But even though “love” is something we give a lot of attention to, it is not something people often understand. So, biblically speaking, what is love? To know what love is, and to live in love, we must understand.

- The nature of love.

Biblical love is action, in spite of feelings, for the good of the other person.

- The source of love:

God himself. It is God's Spirit which produces love in us.

- The call to love.

Though love is a work of God in us, we are still responsible to be loving toward other people.

Conclusion: We are thankful for the power of God which works in us. Let us live in love so that the nature of God may be displayed through us.
