¹ At the center of God's strategy "to reconcile to himself all things," is a whole, new creation by and in Jesus Christ and him crucified. The heartbeat of this new creation is worship, a provision of God's grace in Christ, by which we learn to feel, think, speak, and act as God's good people.

² "Amen" grows from the Hebrew root meaning "true and faithful;" we pray with hope and confidence because our covenant God is "true and faithful" to his covenant promises.

³ "Benediction" is the "good Word" of God's blessing by which He secures, sustains and equips his people by his steadfast, covenantal love in Christ for the display of His glory

Sermon Notes

Passage: **Matthew 5:13-16**

Message: *Fruit of the Spirit: Salt & Light of Righteousness*

Biblically speaking, Paul's outline of the righteous character of God that the Spirit of God is crafting in us – what we call “the fruit of the Spirit” – is only properly understood in view of Jesus' own announcement about what he came to do: “... to bring good news to the poor, bind up the brokenhearted, to give them the garment of praise instead of a faint spirit, so that they may be oaks of righteousness, the planting of the Lord for the display of his glory” (Is 61:1-4) [[And what is THE oil of gladness, THE garment of praise anyway?]]

• *What is this “Righteousness”?*

• *Salt of Righteousness*

• *Light of Righteousness*

This is the substance and significance of our life together in Christ – as the image of his righteousness is formed in us and made visible among us, we display the hope for which our neighbors mourn, and light way through death.
