Peter says that we should not be surprised by trial as if "some strange thing were happening" to us. Some things in life may seem unpredictable. But in all of our world of uncertainty, of these things we can be sure...

...We can be certain of hardships and being misunderstood. And yet...

...We can be sure of God's grace and power. And...

...We can be sure of God's blessing and fruit...

Conclusion: Let us not allow the difficulty of trial keep us from a spirit of perseverance and confidence in our Lord Jesus. For as Paul says, "Always give yourselves fully to the work of the Lord, because you know that your labor in the Lord is not in vain."

Reflect: (Based on Navigator's 5x5x5 Reading Plan) We need to take time in our reading: listen, reflect, dig. Below are 5 different ways you can dig deeper each day. These exercises will encourage your reflection on your reading. Don't try all of them; choose one.

- **Highlight.** Mark key or repeated words and phrases in the passage. Periodically review your markings to discern patterns and themes in what God is teaching you.
- **Re-Word.** Using a small journal, re-read the passage or the verse slowly and then rewrite each phrase or sentence in your own words.
- **Ask.** Questions unlock new discoveries and meanings. Ask Who, What, Why, When, Where, How type questions. Jot down your thoughts as to possible answers.
- **Capture the Big Idea.** God's Word communicates big ideas: periodically ask yourself, "What's God's big idea here?"
- **Personalize.** When God speaks, he is speaking TO his people: what is he saying to his people and how does he expect them to respond?

Pray: Lord our God, great, eternal, wonderful in glory, who keeps covenant and promises for those who love you with their whole heart; who are the life of all, the help of those who flee to you, the hope of those who cry to you; cleanse us from our sins, secret and open, and from every thought displeasing to your goodness. Cleanse our bodies and souls, our hearts and consciences, that with a pure heart and a clear soul, with perfect love and calm hope, we may venture confidently and fearlessly to pray to you. Amen.
