Sermon Notes

Isaiah 13:1-22

The Fall and Rise of Human Pride

We live in an increasingly frightening world with new threats to ourselves and families – nevermind to our very civilization – seeming to arise on every side from every corner almost every day. Twisted and blinded in panic, we find ourselves drawing from the very same wisdom and power out of which arise these threats to defend ourselves against them and defeat them. But if the wisdom and power of these threats are themselves to be destroyed, does it not make sense to rest our hope in whatever wisdom and power that raises up to destroy them?

...The Desolation of Pride...

...The Submission of Pride...

Since God has raised up the signal and scepter of his righteousness in Jesus, conquering the pride in which we so instinctively take refuge and by which we are so treacherously pitted against him, let us turn away from such foolishness to find rest and hope in the midst of our circumstances and so become emblems of that rest and hope for a world stripped of hope and saturated in cynicism.

As we systematically read through the Bible together following this plan, we will gain an appreciation for God's story of Glory, Grace and Truth displayed through the ages among and through his people. Reflect: (Based on Navigator's 5x5x5 Reading Plan)

We need to take time in our reading: listen, reflect, dig. Below are 5 different ways you can dig deeper each day. These exercises will encourage your reflection on your reading. Don't try all of them; choose one.

- **Highlight.** Mark key or repeated words and phrases in the passage. Periodically review your markings to discern patterns and themes in what God is teaching you.
- **Re-Word.** Using a small journal, re-read the passage or the verse slowly and then rewrite each phrase or sentence in your own words.
- **Ask.** Questions unlock new discoveries and meanings. Ask Who, What, Why, When, Where, How type questions. Jot down your thoughts as to possible answers.
- **Capture the Big Idea.** God's Word communicates big ideas: periodically ask yourself, "What's God's big idea here?"
- **Personalize.** When God speaks, he is speaking TO his people: what is he saying to his people and how does he expect them to respond?
