Sometimes when we find ourselves at a dead-end in the middle of nowhere, facing a wall it is best to simply stop running, back away slowly, turn around and begin heading in the very direction from which you've been running.

Continue in Worship through the Week

January 22 – 28, 2012

As we systematically read through the Bible together following this plan, we will gain an appreciation for God's story of Glory, Grace and Truth displayed through the ages among and through his people. It is a story filled with intrigue, deception, colossal failures and even greater stories of redemption. Once this becomes a part of our normal routine, we will be amazed how these stories come to mind in the face of daily life challenges.

- Sunday** (Epistles) Romans 5-6
- Monday** (The Law) Genesis 8-11
- Tuesday** (History) Joshua 11-15
- Wednesday** (Psalms) Psalm 6-8
- Thursday** (Poetry) Job 5-6
- Friday** (Prophecy) Isaiah 12-17
- Saturday** (Gospels) Matthew 5-7

Reflect: We need to take time in our reading: listen, reflect, dig. Below are 5 different ways you can dig deeper each day. These exercises will encourage your reflection on your reading. Don't try all of them; choose one.

- **Highlight.** Mark key or repeated words and phrases in the passage. Periodically review your markings to discern patterns and themes in what God is teaching you.
- **Re-Word.** Using a small journal, re-read the passage or the verse slowly and then rewrite each phrase or sentence in your own words.
- **Ask.** Questions unlock new discoveries and meanings. Ask Who, What, Why, When, Where, How type questions. Jot down your thoughts as to possible answers.
- **Capture the Big Idea.** God's Word communicates big ideas: periodically ask yourself, "What's God's big idea here?"
- **Personalize.** When God speaks, he is speaking TO his people: what is he saying to his people and how does he expect them to respond?

Pray: Lord, you know those who are sore stricken and heavy of heart. As their days, so let their strength be. Heal the sick, comfort the weary, succor the tempted, give peace to the dying and light to the eventide. Watch over us who are still in our dangerous voyage, and remember such as lie exposed to the rough storms of trouble and temptations. Frail is our vessel, and the ocean is wide; but as in your mercy you have set our course, so steer the vessel of our life toward the everlasting shore of peace, and bring us at length to the quiet haven of our heart's desire, where you, O our God, are blessed, and live and reign for ever and ever. *Augustine*
